The Lawrence County Conservation District is accepting applications for a full-time **Agricultural Conservation Technician**.

### Job Description

The Agricultural Conservation Technician provides direct technical and financial assistance to local landowners to conserve and enhance Lawrence County's natural resources. The technician will be responsible for outreach and education to county farm operations, field implementation of conservation practices, writing manure management plans, review of nutrient management plans, and obtaining grant funding for best management practices.

### Requirements

The ideal candidate will hold a Bachelor's Degree with major course emphasis in Agronomy, Agriculture, Geography, Biology, Environmental Science, or other Natural Sciences. Equivalent experience and training may qualify at the discretion of the LCCD.

This position requires strong motivation and initiative, excellent communication and project management skills, organizational abilities, and computer knowledge. Significant time may be spent in the field in areas of rough terrain, in all weather. A valid driver's license and all child abuse history clearances are required. The candidate must be willing to travel for trainings and meetings. Some night and weekend work hours may also be required as part of the position. A strong agricultural background with a good working knowledge of crops, soils, nutrients, animal husbandry, hydrology, land use and geography are a plus. Candidate must be a motivated team player with a great attitude for success.

This is a full-time position with a starting salary of \$40,000 - \$50,000 plus benefits, depending on education and experience.
